- 5. To attend pertinent parish events and training sessions,
- 6. To serve as a liaison to a parish commission and to parish members.
- 7. To use prayer, discernment and the Gospels when making leadership decisions.

QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Faithful participation in worship and sacraments.
- 2. Personal commitment to sharing one's gifts with the parish community.
- 3. Be a registered member of this Parish Community for a period of at least 3 years.
- 4. Willingness to work together as a group to discern the will of God for this parish at this time.
- 5. Strive to be provide visionary leadership while still being grounded in the Catholic faith and tradition.
- 6. Satisfactory completion of the Safe Environments Essential 3, which includes a background check.

AMOUNT OF TIME REQUIRED

4-6 hours per month consisting of meetings, prayer and study.

LENGTH OF COMMITMENT

Three-year term.

TRAINING PROVIDED

Annual retreat, occasional leadership seminars and/or events.

RESPONSIBLE TO

Each member is responsible to God, the Church, the Parish, and the Pastor.

SUPPORT PROVIDED TO

Commissions, committees and parishioners.
